

Amphomag® Neutralization Procedure for One Pot/Shake and Bake Methamphetamine Cook Safety/Disclaimer (Revision Dated 9/1/2013)

- 1. Personnel conducting the outlined procedure must be knowledgeable and trained with dismantling and neutralizing methamphetamine labs as required by their employer and/or regulatory and enforcement agencies.
- 2. Personnel should use the proper personal protection equipment as required by all Federal, State and Local rules and regulations, including but not limited to, fire and chemical protection suits, Flash Fire/chemical resistant gloves, required respiratory protection and eye and face protection.
- **3.** Suitable ancillary equipment to handle and transport methamphetamine labs and other hazardous materials, including any contaminates that may be present, must be employed.
- **4.** Firefighting equipment designed for use in extinguishing chemical fires should be immediately accessible and verified for proper operation prior to beginning any neutralization procedure.
- **5.** Chemicals used for methamphetamine production can vary, therefore recognizing and understanding the hazards of the various chemicals that could be present is required.
- **6.** The neutralization procedure should only be conducted by a user skilled and trained in dismantling One Pot/Shake and Bake Cook Meth Labs.
- 7. Amphomag® Meth neutralized materials should be disposed of properly in accordance with all Federal, State and local laws and regulations.
